Piano

Piano Repertoire classes (PR1 or PR2 or PR3 on your individual timetable)

This year all piano students will participate in repertoire classes. A repertoire class is a large group class where everyone plays the repertoire together – so, just like the other instrument groups at Festival, the piano students will have a large group class experience too. Book 1 repertoire classes may include time on the keyboards and some time doing music enrichment activities of a different nature.

Students should revise the pieces below – as many as they have learned from the appropriate book level list – so they can participate fully in these classes. When there is a piece you can’t play, you will listen to the other students – this is a great way of starting to learn these later pieces.
